

Angola Begins Participation in Ministerial Meeting in Brussels.

Belgium: Headquarters of the European Union

An Angolan delegation headed by the Minister of Commerce, Fiel Domingos Constantino, will represent the country in a meeting that starts today (Sunday) in Brussels (Belgium) and runs until Tuesday (7).

The focus of the meeting is the reinforcement of cooperation between Angola and the European Union (EU). The meeting is part of the cooperation agreement known as the "Joint Angola - European Union Road".

It is an understanding that aims to increase the partnership between Angola and the economic and political union of 28 member states in the areas of security and peace, economic growth, sustainable development, good governance and human rights.

Areas such as energy, transport, environment, science and technology and education are also on the agenda of the meeting at EU headquarters (Brussels).

In three decades of partnership, the European Union has donated 1,050 million euros of development support to Angola, including health, agriculture, education, water resources, human rights, among others.
